Hello, Campers and Parents from your friends at Camp Presmont! We've been busy preparing for you to come to camp, and we're so glad you will be joining us for a fun and meaningful week. It will be a packed week of fun and laughter as campers build friendships and explore God's faithfulness and what it means to follow Jesus. You'll go home inspired and equipped to follow Him in every area of your life. You definitely won't want to miss it.

**Electronics**—Please leave all valuables, including cell phones, iPods, and other electronic devices at home. Part of the camp experience is leaving the distractions of home at home. ***Any electronics brought to camp will be collected and then returned at the end of the camp.*** The camp phone will be available for emergencies. Thanks for helping us make this week memorable and meaningful.

**Check-in/out**—Campers can check in at 7 PM and check out at 6 PM. Once campers arrive and get settled, we'll launch right into our opening activity, so please arrive ready to dive right in to the best week of your summer. If you need to pick up a camper before the check-out time, please send a note indicating when they will be picked up and who will pick them up.

**Medications**—Please label any medications you will bring to camp with your name and instructions on how to take the medication. Only bring what you will need while you are at camp. Any medication left after the camper has checked out will be discarded.

**Spending money**—Our camp store will have t-shirts, cinch bags, hats, blankets, sweatshirts, water bottles, snacks, etc. available for campers to purchase. Merchandise is priced from \$6-\$25. Snacks are \$1. Campers will check their money in when they arrive to prevent loss or theft. This year, we have added credit card pay at camp. If you would like to make a store purchase using a credit card, the store will be open at check-out time. ***This year we will host a camper project giving campers an opportunity to donate their leftover store money to help purchase waterfront equipment and inflatables for the 2018 season. We hope you'll participate.*** ☺

**Email your camper**—This year, you can email your camper while they're at camp. Just visit our website, and click on "email your camper." We'll print that email and deliver it to your camper. Of course, you can still write to your camper and send it in the mail. Be sure to allow time for the letter to arrive before your camper goes home.

**Finally**, this summer we are partnering with YoungLives, a ministry of YoungLife that serves teen moms, in Zanesville and Wheeling. YoungLives provides mentoring, evangelism, and discipleship for teen moms, showing them Jesus and helping them develop as young moms. We will be collecting diapers and other baby supplies to help support the valuable ministry they're doing in our communities. We've included a list of items we will collect all summer that will go to YoungLives. Just fill a plastic grocery bag with baby supplies on that list and bring it with you to camp. We'll take it to YoungLives Zanesville and Wheeling, and they will distribute the items from there. ***If your church has a food pantry, clothes closet, or any other community outreach project that we could support in 2018, please let us know. We would love to partner with you in the future.***
